Guest Policy

Accommodations at the AIAS Kabul Center are intended for persons involved in the study of Afghanistan. AIAS members and representatives of AIAS-affiliated institutions (and their co-workers) have priority.

Fees per night (including breakfast, lunch, dinner snack, internet access):

-- Graduate students	\$50
-- AIAS Executive Committee members	\$55
-- Others	\$65

The rent includes the following services free of the extra charge

Food:

Breakfast, lunch and sapper will be served every day except Friday that the cook will be off but there will be some food in the refrigerator for guest. Guests can also use the kitchen and cook their own meal using the available material of the kitchen all the time.

Tea/ Coffee:

Guest can always have tea or coffee whenever they want. It will be prepared by the cook or guest can make their own tea or coffee.

Internet service:

There is a Wi-Fi internet service at the AIAS house that guest can use free wireless internet connection during the room occupancy.

Car and Driver:

When not in use on staff business during business hours (9-5) Sunday through Thursday, the car and driver are available for guest errands within Kabul for four hours a week free of charge. Guests who want to use the car more than mentioned hour limits will have to rent the car for \$5 / hour.

There is currently one double room ready for occupancy. Add \$15 per night for double occupancy

Bills are payable weekly in cash.

Laundry can be done by the staff for \$5 a pillowcase load.

Luggage and other study-related items may be stored, in reasonable quantities, at the Center. While storage is indoors and relatively secure, AIAS takes no responsibility for damage or loss.

Payment is due weekly / monthly preferable at the beginning of every week.
